- **BUSINESS RESILIENCY:** The OnX Business Resiliency team is in regular contact with Municipal, Provincial, and Federal agencies to monitor the situation and ensure that we are deploying best practices in response to the situation.
- **CRITICAL FUNCTIONS:** OnX has strategies in place to maintain all critical functions. Our network and platforms are designed to allow secure remote access and support by our employees. We will continue to manage and monitor the stability of our network and perform maintenance activity.
- **CUSTOMER SUPPORT:** OnX employees can answer calls, log tickets, and troubleshoot issues remotely should this become necessary.
- **TRAVEL:** OnX has limited all non-essential travel in order to reduce the risk of possible exposure. We implemented this restriction in early February, and will keep this measure in place as long as necessary.
- **ON-SITE SUPPORT:** OnX employees and vendors will continue supporting customers on site unless events require us to adjust this support model. We will, of course, adhere to any customer-initiated restrictions regarding on-site personnel.
